

### **God Promises Fruitfulness (1999)**

Multiplication - that's the word that God gave me on my latest trip to Brazil in July 1999.

The effects of the long journey had begun to take its toll and I began to nod off during one of the afternoon conference sessions. When I resurfaced, the message was all about God's fruitfulness in the life of Abraham and how the Lord brought increase. As I listened, I began to be reminded of what God had said in the past, promising 4,000 people at my own church, King's Way, and felt excited at what He wanted to do in our town of Sale and also our city, Manchester. I also felt that this MULTIPLICATION would extend to the work with the Deborah Arise International project and indeed all areas of my life and ministry.

#### PROPHETIC DANCE

Later in the evening I was so thrilled about God's promises that I danced with movements and gestures which seemed to have prophetic significance. As I danced, the Holy Spirit filled me once more.

#### COMPLIMENTS

Afterwards I happened to compliment a lady on her pendant. She told me she had bought it in Israel and that it was modelled on a fish from the Sea of Galilee which had links to the Bible story of the loaves and fishes - another example of God's abundant provision. Imagine my surprise when the lady removed it from her chain and gave it to me! She felt from God that she should give the pendant to me as a sign of Him wanting to bring multiplication in the life of the wider Church back in England. So, I am wearing this pendant most of the time to remind me of this wonderful promise.

#### CONFIRMATION

Just in case I had not put two and two together that it was God's desire for multiplication in England, a man who knew nothing about me came and prayed over me. Amazingly, he said, "I have a word for June - MULTIPLICATION"!!!

In Goiania, Brazil, was also invited to speak for fifteen minutes on a radio station about the Deborah Project. The station is a secular organisation having some 200,000 listeners each day, but I felt a real sense of freedom to talk about the Project.
